LEGAL NOTICE No. 144

THE HIDE, SKIN AND LEATHER TRADE ACT
(Cap. 359)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 20 (a) of the Hide, Skin and Leather Trade Act, the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries makes the following Rules: —

THE HIDE, SKIN AND LEATHER TRADE (CESS) RULES, 2014

1. These Rules may be cited as the Hide, Skin and Leather Trade (Cess) Rules, 2014.
2. The cess imposed by the Hide, Skin and Leather Trade (Cess) Rules 2014 shall be at the following percentage rates of the free on board (f.o.b.) values:

Suspension dried hides, wet—salted hides, raw cattle hides, calfskins, sheepskins, wool sheepskins and goat skins	two (2%) per cent.
Hides and skins processed to wet—blue (chrome tanned) state	one (1%) per cent.
Hides and skins processed to pickle form	two (2%) per cent.
Hides and skins processed to vegetable crust form	one (1%) per cent.
Hides and skins processed to chrome crust or any other mineral	one (1%) percent.
Hides and skins processed to finished leather.	(0.5%) percent
